## America Arise and Awake to Pray

“What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?

**Mathew 26: 40-41**

Blow the trumpet in Zion, declare a holy fast, call a sacred assembly. Gather the people, consecrate the assembly; bring together the elders, gather the children, those nursing at the breast.

Let the bridegroom leave his room and the bride her chamber. Let the priests, who minister before the LORD, weep between the portico and the altar. Let them say, “Spare your people, LORD. Do not make your inheritance an object of scorn,

### Imagine:

- A neighborhood, city or nation whose values and institutions have been overrun by the grace and presence of God
- A place where divine fire has not merely been summoned, it has fallen
- A society in which natural, evolutionary change has been disrupted by invasive, supernatural power
- A culture that has been impacted comprehensively and undeniably by the Kingdom of God
- A location where kingdom values are celebrated publicly and passed on to future generations.

Let us RETURN, REBUILD and REVIVE America.

### It is possible in your community... it has always been God’s plan:

From the fall of man in the garden, God has always had a plan for redemption: For you, for your family, for every aspect of your community, and even for the land itself. We have seen glimpses of the wonderful plan and blessing of God on the people of Israel *when* they sought him.

*“...seek the peace and prosperity of the city ... Pray to the LORD for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper” (Jeremiah 29:7).*

In the last 2000 years, we have seen sweeping moves of God in response to his people calling upon him: The Moravians, the Wesleys, Charles Finney, Jonathan Edwards, and Evan Roberts are just a few. There are communities and regions, just like the Hebrides Revivals,

where the Lord seems to touch down again and again. Recent reports of revival around the world include the powerful testimonies of God at work as even the land itself is being restored.

**Are you willing to offer yourself for the task of bringing transformation to your community?**

***“Lord, I have heard of your fame; I stand in awe of your deeds, O Lord.  
Renew them in our day, in our time make them known; in wrath remember mercy....  
his glory covered the heavens and his praise filled the earth” (Habakkuk 3:2&3).***

**The Need:**

Look around you—does your community need the touch of God? Are there people in your family, neighborhood, or workplace who do not know the Savior? He is looking for those who will stand in the gap for their communities (Ezekiel 22:30).

You may even say there is too much “rubble,” but you are not alone! During the time of Nehemiah, the people of Judah said, “...*there is so much rubble that we cannot rebuild the wall*” (Neh 4:10). But look at what was accomplished when the people of Judah joined together and established a guard day and night— the wall around Jerusalem was rebuilt, the people returned to the Lord, and the nations around them perceived that it was a work done by God.

***It often begins with one or two people hearing the heartbeat of God  
for a community in need of his transforming power.***

**God is calling you and me to be “history makers” in this day! Do you hear the call? Now is the time to take the first step!**

## The Vision

The dream God has put upon our hearts is to connect the local prayer networks, initiators, leaders and local body of Christ to mobilize incessant and unified prayer for the revival of churches and for the genuine visitation of the Lord in the land of America as we “unite believers in prayer for every community and unite communities in prayer for our nation.”

Our Lord, Jesus Christ, is the one that builds and tears down nations. It is He alone that able to change to course of nation and return the United States to being a leader in worldwide freedom where the Gospel may flourish. We desire to see revival come to our country one community at a time. We desire to see “His kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.” In communities across this country we believe the Lord has appointed men and women who are called of God to speak for Him and organize the Body of Christ to see to:

***See God’s purposes for America fulfilled through  
sustained prayer and Spirit led obedience.***

We must remember H.O.W. this will occur: Humility, Obedience, Work = Pray

Do you feel called to uniting believers in effective, persistent prayer for your community? Do believe that our country is at the place where it is only God that can save us?

If your heart leaps inside of you then we are asking you to prayerfully consider becoming a local Mobilizer. Mobilizers goals are threefold:

**Inform:** We desire to see the Body of Christ understand current issues from a biblical, prophetic perspective to provide effective and focused prayers. Our resources – including the weekly email alert “On Watch in Washington” – provide this point of view.

**Connect:** We desire to see the Body of Christ connect with each other to be encouraged and to experience power that is only found in unity. Our resources – Prayer Websites, Prayer Wall, Prayer Map and our monthly printed newsletter – a uniquely designed to accomplish this.

**Mobilize:** Revivals seem to be proceeded by times of concerted prayer. We believe that every believer can mobilize people to pray for revival in our nation. They can start with their family, their friends, their church and beyond. Mobilized prayer for our communities and the nation could be as simple as bringing this type of prayer to groups (Sunday School, Bible Studies, Small Groups, etc) you are currently involved in at one end of the spectrum all the way to organizing a 24/7 prayer initiative.

## The Approach:

- To make prayer happen day and night in every state of USA through the body of Christ.
- To connect the strong ethnic body of Christ in America to pray for USA: (Indians, Chinese and Koreans, African Christians and South American Christians).
- Strengthen the hands and knees of the army that is praying in every state.
- Right Posture: Hands lifted in surrender; Bended knees in Humility; Eyes filled with TEARS, the language of unified prayer.

## Opportunities to Mobilize

***“I have posted watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they will never be silent day or night. You who call on the Lord, give yourselves no rest...” (Isaiah 62:6).***

### 1. Mobilize Your Family

*“Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it” (Proverbs 22:6).*

- Regularly have a family time of prayer for the nation
- Utilize resources such as the Heritage of Character from the Country of Character Series by Dave Kubal, to train your children. Go to IFAResources.com to learn more.
- Establish a monthly time to pray with other families for the nation and community
- Teach your family by example the power of prayer, fasting, Bible study, and worship

### 2. Mobilize Your Friends (Prayer Group or Bible study)

*“...they raised their voice to God with one accord...” (Acts 4:24).*

There is no end to the possibilities with your prayer group or Bible study group!

- Subscribe to the On Watch In Watch weekly e-mail alert to receive the most current prayer needs of our nation. Go to IFAPray.org/blog to learn more.
- Utilize resources such as the “Country of Character Series” for small group study. Go to IFAResources.com to learn more.
- Establish a First Friday prayer time for your group or direct them to the closest corporate meeting. Go to F3Rocks.com to learn more.
- Use the IFA GAP Apps to further coordinate your prayer group and enable them to receive up to date information made available by Intercessors for America. Go to GetAmericaPraying.com to learn more.

### 3. Mobilize Your Church

*“My house will be a house of prayer for all nations” (Mark 10: 17).*

- Church Pray! – A monthly resource to encourage church congregations to pray for the nation.
- Establish a “Pray for the Nation” group with monthly prayer time for the nation. IFA provides a monthly First Friday Prayer Letter that targets prayer focuses for strategic issues facing our nation.
- Establish a First Friday prayer time for your church. While church leadership needs to be in agreement with establishing the meeting, it does not necessarily require their leadership. Go to F3Rocks.com to learn more.
- Use the IFA GAP Apps to further coordinate your prayer group and enable them to receive up to date information made available by Intercessors for America. Go to GetAmericaPraying.com to learn more.
- Encourage others to subscribe to the On Watch In Watch weekly e-mail alerts to receive the most current prayer needs of our nation. Go to IFAPray.org/blog to learn more.

### 4. Mobilize Your Community by Establishing a Community Prayer Watch:

Community Prayer Watch (CPW) is a community wide effort to see the Body of Christ come together in prayer for their local community and the nation, with leaders from multiple congregations who have a vision to see God move through unity in multiple prayer.

- Pastors meet monthly to pray together for God to move
- Community establishes a 24/7 prayer shield
- Community- wide concerts of prayer
- Prayer gatherings at strategic locations in the community
- Corporate celebrations
- Move toward establishing a 24/7 house
- Encourage prayer on school campuses

*“we prayed to our God,... and posted a guard day and night.” Nehemiah 4:9*

Like the examples of the elders in the gate in Bible times, the power of corporate authority working together releases the blessing of God on a given community.

***“If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves  
and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways,  
I will hear from heaven and heal their land” (II Chronicles 7:14)***

### 5. Community Prayer Events

- Prayer and worship events with local churches
- All night prayer

- Youth worship events
  - Burns- extended times of prayer and worship
  - Solemn Assemblies
  - Strategic prayer and worship- strategically choosing sites (ie north, south, east, west gates to community or county)
  - Joint prayer events, joining with other communities in your state or region
  - National Day of Prayer and the Global Day of Prayer
  - Church blessings
  - Pastors Prayer Meetings
6. Corporate Prayer & Fasting
- Ongoing chain of year round prayer and fasting, with each church taking a day a month to stand in the gap
  - Ongoing chain of prayer 24/7 from homes with individuals or churches covering every hour of the month
  - Joining with other ministries for larger corporate times of prayer and fasting
  - Extended time of prayer and fasting with a facility open for day and night prayer ie. 10 days of prayer between the National Day of Prayer and the Global Day of Prayer
7. 24/7 Prayer House
- Begin with corporate prayer events
  - Build with churches, ministries, and individuals who share common passion
  - Train and raise up worshippers to lead prayer segments
  - Add team of prayer interns willing to commit to the vision for a specific time period
8. Public Declaration of the Word of God
- Bible reading marathon- 90 hours of public reading of the Word of God with participation of local churches, ministries, families, individuals
9. Prayer Walking
- Community
  - Neighborhood (awesome)
  - Strategic locations – strongholds, etc.
  - Seat of Government – community, county, state, etc
  - Preparation for ministry events
10. Community Blessing and Outreach
- Establish team interested in bringing ministry into community
  - Identify groups and individuals willing to serve in specific roles, ie music, food outreach, prayer team, drama, puppets, activities, etc.
11. Other Ideas

- Identify church and ministry contacts to facilitate information to groups
- Identify leaders within each area that are willing to take responsibility
- Recognize that there is an important place for all God's people with a heart to pray, and seek Him for their community
- Establish a communication plan that will work for your community such as GAP
  - “But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat” (Neh. 4:9).

## How do I get started?

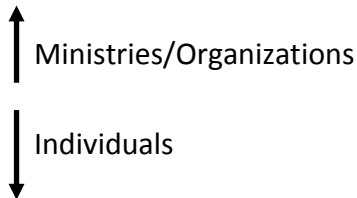

## Biblical Mandate

Deep within the Heart of God is a desire for Nations to follow Him. His purposes and plans for nations are specifically designed to bring Him glory and for His creation to know him intimately (Acts 17:26-28). The Biblical mandate for America and other nations is not complicated. The Ministry of Intercessors for America believes:

1. God has a purpose for America.  
“He makes nations great, and destroys them, He enlarges them, and disperses them.” (Job 12:23)
2. He intends for us to pursue Him, His purposes and ways.  
“Is it not written, My house will be called a house of prayer for all nations.” (Mark 11:17)
3. God desires for us to shape history with Him.  
“If my people ...will humble themselves, pray and seek My face, I will hear from heaven, forgive their sins and HEAL THEIR LAND.” (2 Chronicles 7:14)
4. A country is never too far in decline to find God’s blessing.  
“If that nation I warned repents of its evil, then I will relent.... And if at another time I announce that a nation or kingdom is to be built up and planted, and if it does evil ... I will reconsider the good I had intended to do for it.” (Jeremiah 18:8-9)
5. IFA will be instrumental in America by calling believers to God and His ways.

“God allows people to get the kind of government they want, which could either help accomplish the nation’s destiny or derail it.”

## IFA Values of Mobilization

When it comes to mobilizing people to pray for the nation we believe clear communication and roles are critical for success. Here are the values in which IFA embarks upon mobilizing people to pray for America:

1. We believe that God has wonderful, positive plans for every community that can only be experienced through the prayers of his people

If my **people, who** are **called** by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

2. We believe the Lord has given the Church responsibility for the culture and spiritual atmosphere of communities
3. We believe that within each community the Lord has appointed leaders who are called to shepherd the culture and spiritual atmosphere

And God has placed in the church first of all **apostles**,  
1 Corinthians 12:28

4. We believe that, at times, this leadership is not a recognized function within the Body of Christ

I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one. Ezekiel 22:30

5. We believe that a specialized ministry, like IFA, can be the platform to call out that role within the kingdom and bring it into its rightful function
6. We believe that specialized ministries are ordained of God to serve the Body of Christ and honor the local Body of Christ within the parameters of that ministry's calling and purposes

## **Job Description of Mobilizer**

**Non-Negotiable Aspects:** Leaders with a growing relationship with Jesus Christ with Godly character; A passion and desire to see God move within a community and a nation; Humility and pursuit of unity within the Body of Christ

**Negotiables:** Strategies; Tactics; Methods

### **Informs Believers**

Develops strategies to inform believers of relevant issues

Communicates to a wide audience on how prayer and fasting can change history with heavy emphasis on First Friday

### **Connects and Recruits Believers**

Connects critical relationships between spiritual leaders within communities

Partners with existing organizations to be involved in local prayer events (NDP, Call2Fall, etc.)

Connects those who want to minister to governing officials with opportunities developing “spiritual beach heads” in all governing bodies

Recruits and selects potential candidates for volunteers/staff

Conducts volunteers and ensures ongoing training of volunteers

Develops local area’s volunteers plan

### **Mobilizes Believers**

Encourages believers to pray for local political issues and governing officials

Trains believers how to be involved in monitoring and impacting the community moral atmosphere

Ministers personally to governing and business leaders with aim to act as the guardian of the moral and spiritual atmosphere of the area

### **(Optional) Develops and implements a plan to fund the position**

Builds a personal support team

Develops a plan for a well balanced funding plan emphasizing recurring revenue

Networks to expand and form Local Leadership Team in each area

## Training: Intercessors for America is Committed to You

IFA is committed to helping you mobilize prayer in your community.

### What We Don't Do

- We don't directly endorse one party's political agenda; it's not about an Elephant or Donkey, it is about the kingdom of the Lamb!
- We do not endorse political candidates
- We do not financially contribute to political candidates
- We do not condemn individuals, but rather pray that the Lord would bless all
- We honor all political offices as offices appointed by our Lord

## Expectations

### Key Measurements

We understand that it is God that causes growth, but we also understand that we must do certain things to provide the environment for God to work. That is why we will provide feedback on the following measurements:

- Number of People Committed to Prayer
- Number of OWIW Subscriptions and Prayer Letter Subscribers
- Number of GAP Websites
- Number of Mobilizers
- Number of established Coalitions
- Number of Prayer Events
- Number of Personal Prayer Groups

### Communication/Reporting

We desire to serve our Mobilizers the best we can. In order to be effective we desire regular communication. The Kingdom is all about relationships and we desire to have a very strong supportive role with our Mobilizers. It is our desire to have a very strong relational approach to mobilizing prayer. With this in mind we ask that:

- Once month communication with IFA Mobilization Coordinator: Conference call, Emails, Testimonies, etc.

### Use of Database

Ministry is all about relationships and effectively serving those you are called to serve. In order to do this we have a very effective database called eTapestry.

- Regional Mobilizers may have access to the database with proper training.
- All information in the database remains property of IFA and cannot be used, stored or distributed for purposes other than official IFA activities.

### Use of Logo/Brand

All Mobilizers are allowed to use the IFA logo for approved IFA activities. No changes or alterations of the logo are permissible without approval from IFA national Office.

### Handling Money/Contracts

All ministries need resources to be effective. IFA Mobilizers have the authority to raise money locally for ministry expenses and personal salaries. Here are a few basic guidelines:

- All local money raised by local representatives and staff may remain accessible for the ministry activities
- A local account will be established and maintained by the IFA National office.

- All money raised in the name of Intercessors for America must be receipted by the IFA National office.
- All money is to be sent to the IFA office within 15 days of receiving the check.
- A flat 8% will be retained by IFA National Office for overhead expenses.
- All local funds would be used at the discretion of the IFA National Board if the local effort disbands
- No party is to sign contracts obligating Intercessors for America without review and approval of IFA National Office

## What's Your Passion

Now that you have a brief understanding of Intercessors for America's vision, we would like for you to take a few moments to seek the Lord and focus upon His call upon your life.

Read Ephesians 2:10. The interesting part of this verse is that it draws to light a consistent biblical theme that God has created us for a special purpose and that purpose has been prearranged for us. God does desire us to understand not only our strengths and weaknesses, our gifts and talents, but also the specific calling upon our lives as we fit into His activity and extension of His kingdom.

When Israel crossed the Jordan River into the promised land, God gave Joshua the instructions to have 12 stones brought across the river with them and placed on the other side to make an altar. These stones were to be a sign to the Israelites. The stones were to be a reminder to the Israelites as to what God did in their lives to accomplish His calling and destiny upon their lives.

In fact, God had a habit of doing this with His followers. Select two of the following passages and read about their encounter with God:

- Noah Genesis 6-8
- Moses Exodus 17:8-16
- Abram Genesis 12:1-9
- Joshua Joshua 3:5-4:9
- Isaac Genesis 26:17-25
- Gideon Judges 6:11-24
- Jacob Genesis 28:10-22 & 35:1-7
- Samuel I Samuel 7:1-13

Now answer the following questions:

1. Briefly describe the encounter between those people and God. What did God do?
2. Why do you think the person built an altar or set the stone marker? What, if any, special names of God or of the stone or altar are given in the text?

These markers were significant in the individuals' lives, but they also became important in the lives of the Israelites. You see God works in sequence to accomplish His divine purpose.

What He did in the past was done with the kingdom purpose in mind. What He is doing in the present is in sequence with the past and the same kingdom purpose in mind. Every act of God builds upon the past with a view toward the future.

This is how God has worked and continues to work in this world, but also in our individual lives. Consider the spiritual markers in your life. Consider those times of transition, decision or direction when you clearly knew that God was guiding you. Over time God has interacted with you and you can remember moments of significance where you knew that

God was forming you and your life.

At this point one needs to understand the importance of prayer. Another possibility is to have the statement framed and hang it on the wall by the door you use to come into and out of your house, thus reminding you every time you leave what you are supposed to be about.
