## 1. Mobilize Your Family

#### 4. Mobilize Your Community by Establishing a Community Prayer Watch

Community Prayer Watch (CPW) is a communitywide effort to see the Body of Christ come together in prayer for the local community and the nation, with leaders from multiple congregations who have a vision to see God move through unity in prayer.

Like the examples of the elders in the gate in Bible times, the power of corporate authority working together releases the blessing of God on a given community.
